Travel time is approximately 1 hour 15 minutes.

From Oneida, TN: Travel Hwy 27 north and cross the state line into Kentucky, go to the third stop light (#3)and turn left onto Hwy 92 west, travel approximately ¼ mile and turn right onto Raider Way, follow Raider Way

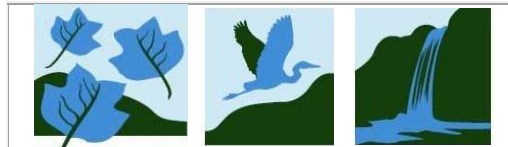
